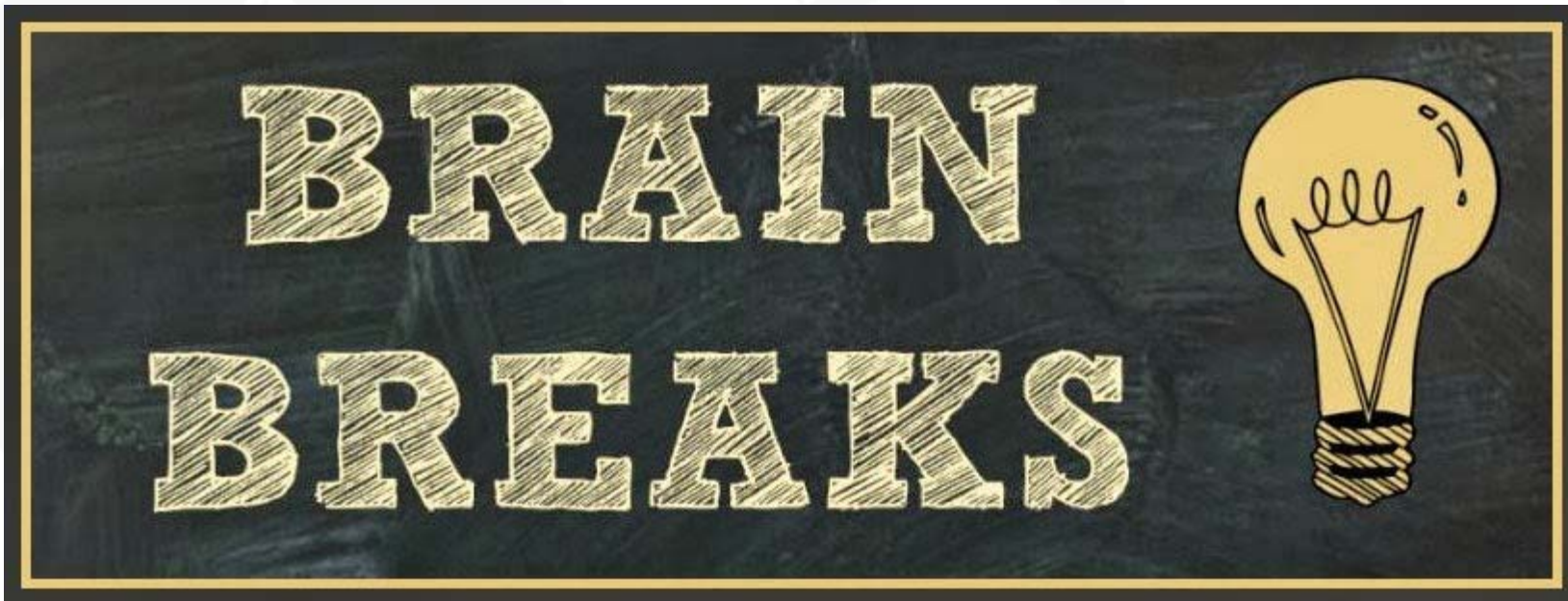
Supplement Not Supplant

In general, LEAs cannot use SSAE program funds if the cost for the activities would have been paid with State or local funds in the absence of SSAE program funds.

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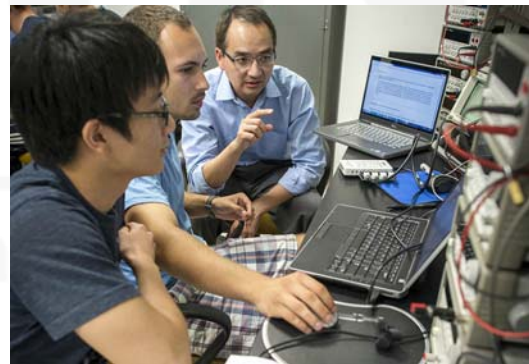

STEM



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STEM jobs are growing faster than those in other professions, do not end up qualified for STEM fields.

In higher education, nearly half the bachelor's degree students who started with a STEM major between 2003 and 2009 switched to a non-STEM major or dropped out.

Young people are interested in science—but lack engaging, accessible learning experiences and lose interest and miss opportunities for success



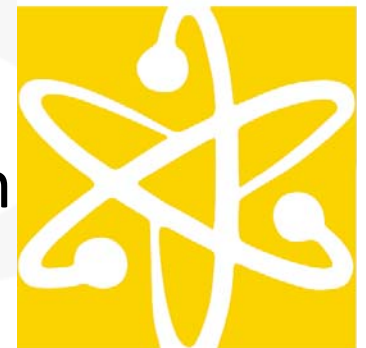
