

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

87%



    - Additional Responsibilities distributed leadership
    - Virtual Training Opportunities
    - Best Practices (team building/site-based management/charter law)
    - Budgets

  - Stakeholders Who is required to be on the team?
  - Planning and Preparation
    - How did the team ensure that the selection of stakeholders created an inclusive group with varied perspectives?
    - How will the team ensure that stakeholders are able to provide meaningful feedback throughout the needs assessment process?
  - Title I Teachers, Administrators, Federal programs staff
  - **Title II** Teachers, paraprofessionals, Administrators, Federal programs staff, specialized staff

### **Coherent Instructional System**

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The major system of the complex school organization that articulates and guides the what and how of instruction (Georgia's Systems of Continuous Improvement)

### Coherent Instructional System

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- Articulated charter school mission and vision aligned with curricula
- Clear Educational Plan
  - Teach students where they are and move them forward
- Opportunities for teachers to master their craft
  - Implement the plan with fidelity
- Systems of prevention/intervention
- Common Assessments to reach every child
  - Strengths
  - Learning Styles
  - Interests
- Data used to tweak the plan

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

### **Supportive Learning Environment**


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- School Environment



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
